RECYCLING



DR SPOCK

- New parents are always worried that they might be making a mistake with their new baby. The baby cries, and they don't know if they should let him cry or pick him up. The baby is sick, and they don't know what to do. "Trust yourself. You know more than you think you do," wrote Benjamin Spock in his famous book *Dr. Spock's Baby and Child Care*, which first appeared in 1946.
- 2 Before Dr. Spock's book appeared, John Watson was the leading child-care expert in the 1920s and 1930s. He wrote, "Never hug or kiss your children; never let them sit in your lap."
