The Proficiency in Academic English Exam (PAE) given by the English Language Preparatory Program is administered in two stages. This guide provides detailed information about Stage 1 and 2. Contact information is given below for your questions.

GENERAL REMINDERS

- You must **not** bring a bag or any other personal belongings with you; there are **no** facilities for storing your personal belongings. The University cannot take responsibility for personal belongings that are left unattended. No exceptions will be made.
- You must **not** bring a mobile phone with you; there are **no** facilities for storing your mobile phones. The University cannot take responsibility for mobile phones that are left unattended. No exceptions will be made.
- Metal detectors are in use and any mobile phone you try to bring into the exam building will be detected. You **cannot** enter the exam building if you have a mobile phone. There are **no** facilities for storing your mobile phones. If you bring a mobile phone with you, it will have to be left unattended. The University cannot take responsibility for mobile phones that are left unattended. No exceptions will be made.
- You must not have any accessories such as smartwatches, necklaces, earrings, or rings on you when coming to the exam. You cannot enter the exam with these accessories. There are **no** facilities for storing these belongings. The University accepts no responsibility regarding this matter, and there are no exceptional circumstances.
- Only those students who have their Bilkent University ID Card can enter the PAE exam. Students who do not have a Bilkent University ID card are required to obtain a 'Student Identification Document with Photograph' from the Registrar's Office before the exam dates in order to be eligible to take the exam. Students who do not have their Bilkent University Student ID card or a 'Student Identification Document with Photograph' 'issued by the Registrar's Office will not be permitted to take the exam.

Special Arrangements for Documented Health Conditions

The English Language Preparatory Program is committed to providing fair and accessible examination conditions for all students. If you have a documented health condition, learning difficulty, or temporary injury, you may be eligible for special arrangements during the PAE exam. To request these arrangements, please submit an official medical report to the Dean of Students' Office. Once your documentation is reviewed and approval is given, please send an email to prep@bilkent.edu.tr so that appropriate accommodations can be provided based on your specific needs.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR STUDENTS TAKING PAE STAGE 1

- Students are required to sit both stages of the PAE Exam. Those who do not take the exams will not be assigned to classes in the English Language Preparatory Program.
- PAE Stage 1 is a multiple choice exam consisting of 200 questions of different levels of difficulty. The questions are designed to test a student's knowledge of grammar and vocabulary.
- Each question has five options. Correction for guessing is implemented.
- Students code their answers onto the optic form provided. Answers written on the question booklet are not acceptable.
- Students are expected to arrive at the exam building by 09.30 a.m. at the latest.
- Students are not allowed to leave the exam room during the first 30 minutes (10.10-10.40)
- Students are not allowed to leave the exam room during the last 10 minutes (11.45-11.55)
- There are no breaks given during the exam.
- Students who arrive later than 10.20 a.m. will not be allowed to take the exam.
- Students should bring the following documents with them:
 - Exam entrance slip issued during registration (for 2026 entry students only);
 - Bilkent University student ID card issued during registration;
 - An official ID card (the national ID card, driver's license or passport).
- Students are not allowed to enter the exam building with personal belongings such as mobile phones, electronic devices, watches or bags. Students are advised not to bring any of these articles with them.

- A pencil, eraser and sharpener will be provided by the University. Students do not need to bring their own stationery.
- Students who pass PAE Stage 1 are eligible to sit PAE Stage 2 Part A.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR STUDENTS TAKING PAE STAGE 2 PART A

- Students who pass PAE Stage 1 are eligible to sit PAE Stage 2 Part A.
- Stage 2 Part A consists of four sections (Reading, Grammar, Vocabulary and Listening). The exam is designed for students at B2 level in English.
- All the sections contain multiple choice questions. Each multiple choice question has five options. Penalty for guessing is 0.25 points for each wrong answer.
- Students code their answers onto the optic form provided. Answers written on the question booklets are not acceptable.
- Students are expected to be in the exam room at 09.15 at the latest.
- Students who arrive later than 09.40 will not be allowed to take the exam.
- Students are not allowed to leave the exam room during the exam.
- There are no breaks given during the exam.
- Students should bring the following documents with them:
 - Exam entrance slip issued during registration (for 2025 entry students only);
 - Bilkent University student ID card issued during registration;
 - An official ID card (the national ID card, driver's license or passport).
- Students are not allowed to enter the exam building with personal belongings such as mobile phones, electronic devices, watches or bags. Students are advised not to bring any of these articles with them.
- A pencil, eraser and sharpener will be provided by the University. Therefore, students do not need to bring their own stationery.
- Students who pass PAE Stage 2 Part A are eligible to sit PAE Stage 2 Part B.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR STUDENTS TAKING PAE STAGE 2 PART B

- Students who pass PAE Stage 2 Part A are eligible to sit PAE Stage 2 Part B.
- Stage 2 Part B consists of two sections (Writing and Speaking).

Writing Exam

- Students are expected to be in the exam room at 09.15 at the latest for the writing exam.
- Students who arrive later than 09.40 will not be allowed to take the exam.
- Students are not allowed to leave the exam room during the last 10 minutes - 10.55-11.05
- There are no breaks given during the exam.
- Students should bring the following documents with them:
 - Exam entrance slip issued during registration (for 2025 entry students only);
 - Bilkent University student ID card issued during registration;
 - An official ID card (the national ID card, driver's license, or passport).
- Students are not allowed to enter the exam building with personal belongings such as mobile phones, electronic devices, watches, or bags. Students are advised not to bring any of these articles with them.
- Students should only bring a pen with them to the exam.

Speaking Exam

- Students are expected to be present in front of the exam room 10 minutes before their exam time.
- Students should bring the following documents with them:
 - Exam entrance slip issued during registration (for 2025 entry students only);
 - Bilkent University Student IDs issued during registration;
 - An official ID card (the national ID card, driver's license, or passport).

INFORMATION ABOUT PAE STAGE 2 PART A

PAE Stage 2 Part A consists of four sections: Reading, Grammar, Vocabulary and Listening.

All the sections contain multiple-choice questions as indicated below. The answers are coded directly onto the optic form.

Reading, Grammar and Vocabulary Exam (1 hour and 45 minutes):

The reading exam has three parts made up of a number of reading texts and all questions are multiple choice. The reading texts vary in length. The aim of the reading exam is to assess students' ability to understand main ideas, supporting details and specific information, follow text coherence, make inferences and guess the meaning of vocabulary from context.

The grammar exam consists of two texts and all questions are multiple choice.

The vocabulary exam consists of two texts and all questions are multiple choice.

Listening Exam (55 minutes):

The listening exam has two sections. Each listening text is listened to once only. In the first section, the aim is to assess students' ability to understand supporting details and specific information and make inferences while listening. Students are expected to answer multiple choice questions as they listen to different dialogues. In the second section, the aim is to assess students' ability to understand main ideas, supporting details and specific information, and make inferences. Students take notes while listening to a lecture and then are given 15 minutes to answer multiple choice questions which are distributed after the lecture has finished.

Time is given at the end of the listening section to transfer answers to the optic form.

INFORMATION ABOUT PAE STAGE 2 PART B

PAE Stage 2 Part B consists of two sections: Writing and Speaking

Writing Exam - Tasks 1 and 2 (1 hour and 35 minutes):

In the first part of the writing exam, students are given a reading text and a prompt based on the text. They are expected to write a paragraph of approximately 150 words responding to the prompt.

In the second part of the writing exam, students are given two topics and asked to choose one and write a 350-word essay on the topic they have chosen.

Speaking Exam (approximately 7 minutes)

The speaking exam consists of a conversation between the student and the assessor. The exam is recorded.
